

NEW SERIES 50 EPC PULLEYS LAUNCHED

New to the William Kenyon range of rope threading equipment is the Series 50 EPC (Extra Protection Collar) pulley. Designed to be used in high contamination areas, where reduced bearing life is common, the pulley utilizes the same bearing and bushing design as the standard series 50 pulley but with an extended collar.



The collar shields the bushing and bearing arrangement to minimize the chance of bearing contamination.

Manufactured from nylon, the collar is a lightweight unit and resistant to oils and grease.

Typically to be used in press sections and wet areas, the collars are available on Single Rope Return, Separator and Transfer pulleys.

Series 33 bore size options

A bushing arrangement has been designed for the Series 33 pulley series that provides greater flexibility over the choice of bore size. Previously the

range has been limited to 35mm and 1 1/4" based on the bearing bore. The new insert can be used for between 25mm and 30mm.



Favini installs rodless tensioner

As part of a dry end rebuild project, Favini spa in Italy requested a new rope system to pick up the tail after the last dryer and carry through to the drum reel release.

The scope included a new tensioning unit positioned in the basement. A low maintenance vertical rodless design was supplied to allow for greater flexibility in relation to space and mounting requirements.
